minutes

Route 1 & 23 Replace Route 1B

Travel on Avon Street Extended, Mill Creek Drive, and Route 20 between Downtown and Piedmont Virginia Community College instead of Monticello Avenue, Rialto Street, and Montrose Avenue. Transfer service

on Monticello Avenue and Rialto Street to Route 3.

Route 2 Replace Route 2B

Travel north & south Old Lynchburg Road, with the end of the line at Southwood, instead of Oak Hill Drive and Hickory Street. Remove

Region 10 deviation.

Route 3 & 21 Between Alta Vista Avenue and Rialto Street travel on Monticello Avenue

and Rialto Street to Belmont Park rather than on Alta Vista Avenue.

Route 4 Transfer service on Bailey Road, Prospect Avenue, Forest Hills Avenue,

Forest Ridge Road and Rockcreek Road to Route 6. Streamline route to

operate via Cherry Avenue bi-directionally.

Route 5 Exit Fashion Square to the east and discontinue service on Berkmar

Drive between Seminole Trail and West Rio Road.

Route 6 & 22 Between Raymond Road and UVA Hospital use Brookwood Drive to

serve Bailey Road and Forrest Hills segments from Route 4. Operate

route bi-directionally.

Route 7 Travel on Water Street and 2nd Street between West Main Street and

Market Street instead of Ridge/McIntire Road. Makes path of travel the same as FREE Trolley. Add 15 minutes of running time to weekday and

Saturday morning schedule to improve on-time performance.

Route 9 Travel on 10th Street between Page Street and Grady Avenue rather than

Page Street and 9th Street to Preston Avenue.

Route 10A & 24 Replace Route 1A and parts of Route 10

Travel on Meade Avenue, High Street, and Highway 250 between Market Street and Pantops Shopping Center instead of East Market Street loop. Connect County areas north of Highway 250 to Martha Jefferson Hospital

via Rolkin Road and State Farm Boulevard.

Route 10B Replace Route 2A and parts of Route 10

Travel on Locust Avenue, River Road and Highway 250 between High Street and Pantops Shopping Center instead of Park Street loop. Connect County areas south of and along Highway 250 to Martha Jefferson Hospital via Pantops Drive, Peter Jefferson Parkway, and State

Farm Boulevard.
